




Discharge and escalation advice



You may need to give your child's blue inhaler every 4 hours initially. As your child gets better, they should need this less often. You should book your child a post asthma attack review at your GP practice 48 hours after discharge. If you are concerned, or your child needs more than 10 puffs within 4 hours you must seek urgent medical help.
