

Care Coordination

Our specialist triage nurses find patients the support they need 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.



- Planned Care (District Nurses) Provide holistic, high quality nursing care for housebound adults in the community
- Rapid Intervention Team Advanced and specialist practitioners provide assessment, diagnostics and treatment for admission avoidance and end-of-life planning
- → Hospital at Home Manage Intravenous antibiotic administration, subcutaneous medications and trials without catheter in the community.
- ◆ Virtual Ward Remote monitoring for adults and paediatrics. Supporting patients with acute and chronic illnesses to facilitate early discharge and admission avoidance.
- Rapid Access to Social Care Personal social care for patients in their own homes to facilitate early discharge and admission avoidance.
- ◆ Community Intermediate Care Team Short term rehabilitation - focused interventions to facilitate hospital discharge or prevent admission provided by a multidisciplinary team
- Ambulatory Clinics Catheter and wound care for people able to attend clinics.
- Anticoagulation & Phlebotomy Clinics and domiciliary care
 providing anticoagulation therapy,
 monitoring and phlebotomy.
- ◆ SDEC (Same day emergency care) 4 acute care locations offering an alternative route to hospital care from A&E.
