Support in the Community

If you have had a stroke and are admitted to hospital you will be reviewed by a Community Stroke Specialist either at home or by telephone within the first 6 weeks after your discharge. If you have not been admitted you will be reviewed as soon as possible either at home or in clinic depending on your symptoms. If you are struggling to cope before your appointment please call us as soon as possible and we shall endeavour to help. If it's a medical problem please call your GP.

What we do

During your first visit we will address some of the following:

- How you are recovering
- A review of stroke medication
- Whether you are receiving the right services
- Review your risk factors for stroke such as high blood pressure and diabetes management
- Provide advice on healthy lifestyle, for example, support to stop smoking, eat a healthy diet and take part in physical activity
- Provide advice on other issues such as pain, mood, driving, return to work or other leisure activities.

We will work with you to ensure that you are able to make the best recovery possible following your stroke and signposting you onto the services you require. You will be reviewed regularly in the year following your stroke.
