

# Care of your wound after surgery

Dermatology Outpatients Unit Cannock Chase Hospital

The prevention of infection is a major priority in all healthcare and everyone has a part to play.

- Please decontaminate your hands frequently for 20 seconds using soap and water or alcohol gel if available
- If you have symptoms of diarrhoea and/or vomiting, cough or other respiratory symptoms, a temperature or any loss of taste or smell please do not visit the hospital or any other care facility and seek advice from 111
- Keep the environment clean and tidy
- Let's work together to keep infections out of our hospitals and care homes.

# How can I look after my wound, following surgery?

There are a number of things that you can do to look after your wound to lower the chance of infection and encourage healing.

- Keep the wound clean and dry until removal of your dressing, (for the time advised by the nurse team, unless this is being removed at a wound review appointment) (see opposite for details)
- If removing your own dressing, once removed, wash with clean water only and gently pat dry, continue with this until your sutures have been removed or dissolved away
- Apply a thin layer of Vaseline (from a new pot) twice daily over the sutures until removed or dissolved away
- Avoid any form of exercise including, lifting, pushing, pulling or carrying anything heavy, until your sutures have been removed or dissolved away, however for legs and backs we recommend a month
- Avoid alcohol for 48 hours
- Any bleeding, apply firm pressure directly over the wound for 15 minutes, if necessary repeat for a further 15 minutes
- If you have any pain from the wound, take Paracetamol as per recommended dosage guidelines
- If you are concerned about your wound; bleeding after applying recommended pressure, increasing pain, redness, discharge, odour or swelling, you can contact us on the numbers provided for advice, if you leave a message please state your name and hospital number and a current telephone number
- If for any reason you are unable to contact us please call your GP, 111 for advice or visit A&E in case of an emergency.

## Post Operative Massage

- One week after your suture removal or when sutures have dissolved you can start to massage the scar applying gentle to firm pressure
- Do this for 5 minutes, 4 times a day, for 6 months-massaging in all directions
- You may wish to use **Vaseline or un-fragranced moisturiser** to help you do this more easily.
