Keep Lateral Flow Tests at home.

Lateral Flow Devices are available through local participating community pharmacies. This is a walk-in service where you can collect a free box of five lateral flow devices. You can collect further free lateral flow devices from the pharmacists when you run out.

If you have one of these conditions you may be entitled to COVID-19 treatment.

- Patients with Down's Syndrome and other genetic disorders
- Patients with Sickle cell disease
- Patients with a solid cancer

- Patients with haematological diseases and stem-cell transplant recipients
- Patients with renal disease
- Patients with liver disease
- Patients with immune-mediated inflammatory disorders (IMID)
- Patients with respiratory conditions
- Patients with immune deficiencies
- Patients with HIV or AIDS
- Solid organ transplant recipients
- Patients with rare neurological and complex life-limiting neurodisability conditions, including Dementia with severe frailty, Multiple Sclerosis, Huntington's disease, Myasthenia Gravis and Parkinson's Disease.
