
QbTest information leaflet

QbTest helps us to know how much your body moves, how you pay attention, and how easy or hard it is for your brain to stop and think.

QbTest does not hurt.



There is a stretchy band with a ball on it that will be worn around your head.


There is a camera that does not take pictures. The camera only sees the ball.

The camera does not see you.




You will press a button when you see shapes on a computer screen.

The person who brings you to do the task can see the room with you. The person who brings you will wait outside the room during the task.


