Important Announcement

A new organisational approach is being taken on Functional Skills Requirements for Apprenticeships.

From the 1st August 2025
All new apprenticeship applicants for level 3 or above that do not already hold Math & English qualifications of a minimum GCSE C/4 or equivalent, will be required to complete the Functional Skills Qualification, either alongside their apprenticeship or before enrolment.

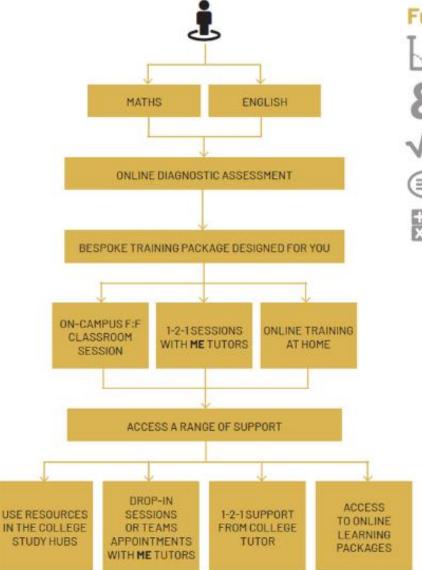

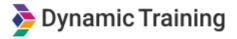
